Call for Participation

The SPE Aberdeen Section (SPE Aberdeen) and Aberdeen Renewable Energy Group (AREG) proudly bring you the first **Scottish Energy Futures Conference** – focused on deploying the technologies necessary to make the energy transition happen.

We recognise that energy transition is a journey over many years – today we need to decarbonise oil and gas production as it still supplies over 80% of global energy needs – but the pace of development of a wide range of technologies means that tomorrow's energy systems will look very different. Recognising the urgency of the need to tackle climate change this conference looks at a range of decarbonisation projects that are happening now – and looks to the future to see what technologies might finally deliver the goal of “net zero”



Call for Abstracts

Deadline 15th November

The aim of this event is to share knowledge and advance the industry as we work towards the Energy Transition. If you have experiences to share, then we would like to invite you to submit your 200-word abstract for consideration for the 2024 conference programme.

We are interested in hearing about your case studies and lessons learned, innovative technologies, and experiences, that focus on, but not limited to the following themes:

- **Renewable Power Supply** including offshore platform electrification from shore, offshore wind to supply power to offshore platforms, onshore wind and solar.
- **Making Hydrogen** – blue and green hydrogen technology
- **Using Hydrogen**
- **Offshore Power Grids** including offshore-to-onshore connectivity, onshore grid including pylon debate, subsea substations and transformer platforms
- **Geothermal**
- **Tidal & Wave Energy** including wave technology and underwater turbines
- **Emerging Low Carbon** Technologies including hydrogen storage, pumped storage, batteries
- **Nature based solutions**, including Forestry, Peat bog remediation, Ocean sequestration etc



How to Submit your Abstract

Presentations will last 20 minutes with 10 minutes for questions.

Note that formal SPE papers are not required. Submit your 200 word abstract [here](#) indicating '20 minute' as the presentation format by 15th November.



Call for Techbyte Pitches

Deadline 15th November

In an effort to raise the profile of new and emerging technologies we are offering an exciting opportunity for technology companies, startup and academics to deliver a “Techbyte” pitch at our conference.

Each day before lunch there will be five presentations by selected technology providers who will be limited to one slide and a strict 3-minute time slot. The two categories are as follows:

- New technologies that are available for deployment today (TRL 7-9) OR
- Emerging technologies that still need further development before they are market-ready (TRL 306)

If you would like to present your Techbyte in this way, please submit a 200 word abstract [here](#) indicating the TRL category. The committee will review the submissions and invite shortlisted companies to make their presentation at a pitching session in February 2025. The best presentations will be selected for showcasing at the Conference.

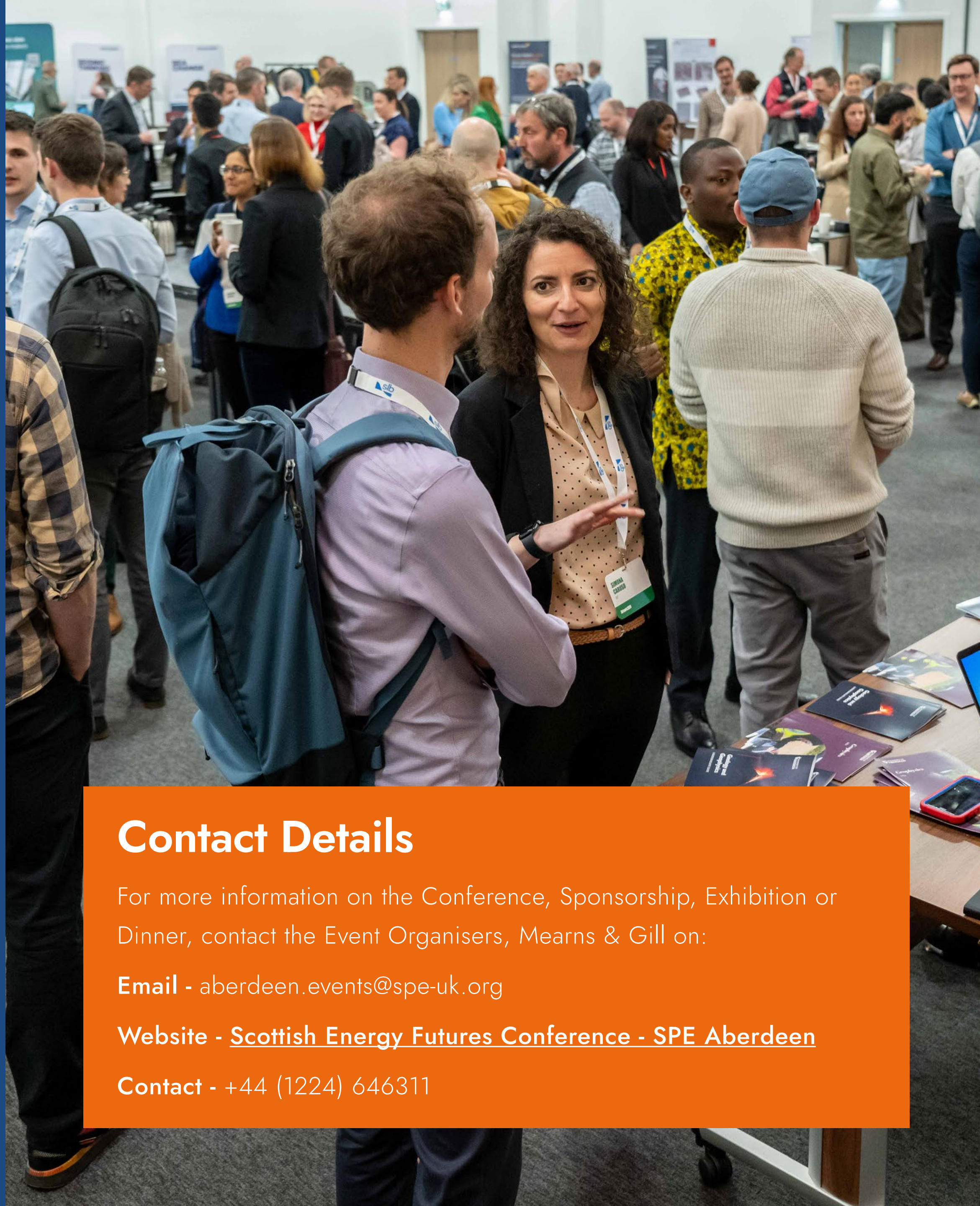
